Elisabeth first visited Snape at the age of 5 to stay with her grandmother who lived at the White House in Sandy Lane, Snape.

In 1979 the White House became her home when she returned to live in Snape. Since then she has been a most active member of the village community, including a member of the Snape Parish Church Parochial Church Council and the Women's Institute.

In the days leading up to the Suffolk Show, a Festival Torch will be carried around the county to celebrate local communities and to honour local heroes. The Relay will cover 550 miles and over 250 communities.
