

Snape sluice detailed asset inspections

River Alde, Snape

What are we telling you about?

Our work to undertake detailed asset inspections to the Snape sluice.

Where is this work happening?

We will be undertaking these inspection works to the various elements up-stream and down-stream of the Snape sluice (NGR TM 39088 57632).

When are we doing the work?

The work will start on 6 September 2021 and last for 1 week.

What will we be doing?

We will perform various intrusive tests to parts of the sluice structure including to the flap valves, headwall, dividers and sheet pile walls.

Vehicular access to the sluice will be through an off-road access track as shown on the map overleaf. It is unlikely that we will cause any damage but if any damage does occur as a result of our work we will repair it to the standard it was when work started.

How will this work benefit you?

The work will ensure our flood defence structure is inspected regularly and if required, further repair works to be planned and delivered to the structure.

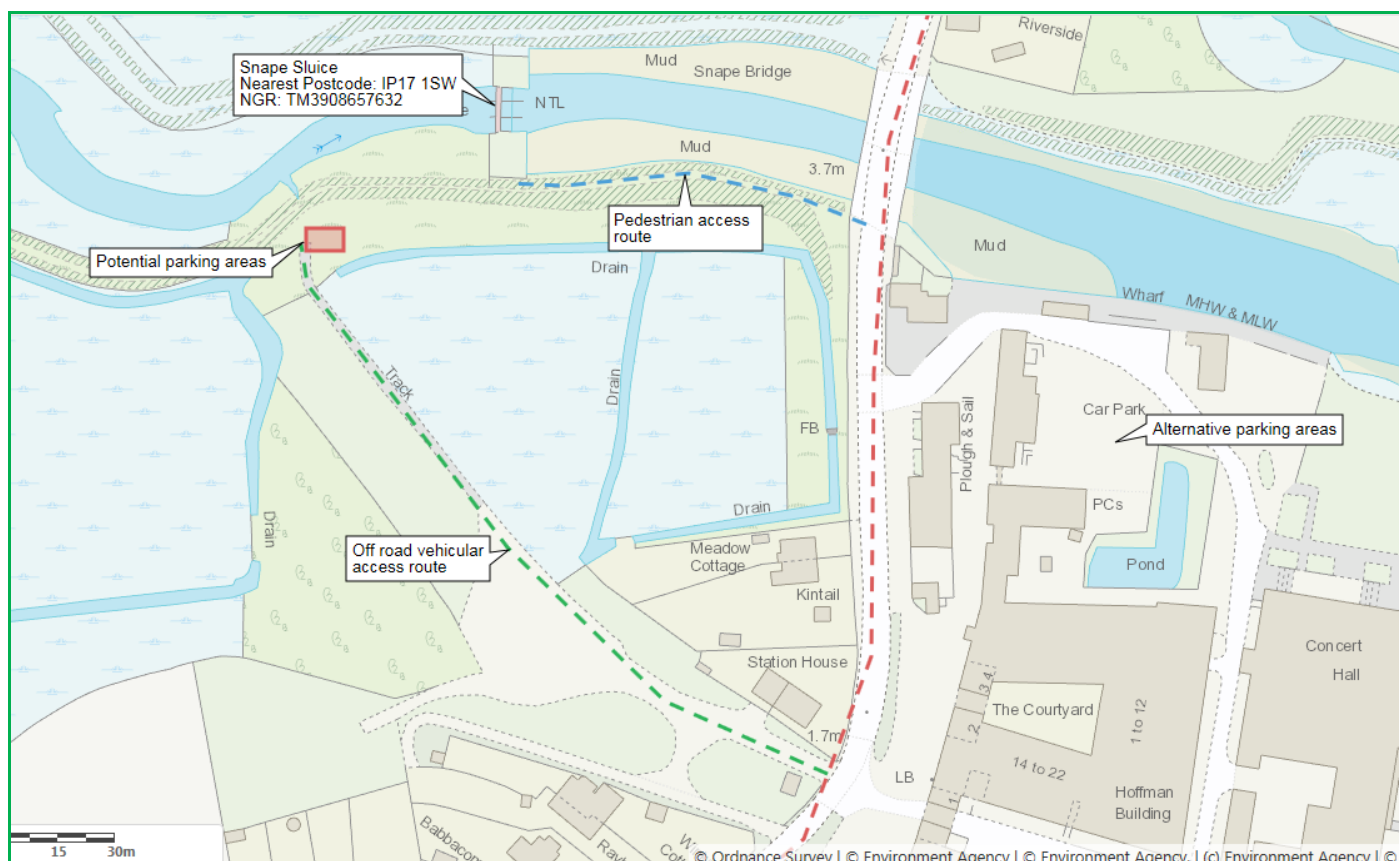
